More important information about the 2010 Mid-Year Exam Schedule:

- There will be three 1 ½ hour exams each day with a 30-minute break between each exam
- The café will be open: → 7:15 – 8:00 with a breakfast menu (There will be no breakfast on Monday, February 1)
 → 9:30 – 12:30 with a limited lunch menu (No lunch on Monday, February 1)
- A student with three exams scheduled for the same day may reschedule one for Monday, February 1.
 - All missed exams due to absences will be verified with a parent or guardian.
 - February 1 will be used for make ups due to illnesses and previously rescheduled exams.
 - Any conflicts or exceptions should be approved by an administrator.
- Students can obtain the optional Rescheduling Notification Forms in guidance, main office, or the library from Friday, January 8 – Friday, January 22.

If a student chooses to reschedule an exam, he/she must:

- Complete Rescheduling Notification Form for each day they have a triple exam by Friday, January 22.
- Choose one of the three exams to reschedule to Monday, February 1.
- Choose an exam time slot on Monday, February 1 that best fits the student's and teacher's schedule.
- Give the completed form to the teacher giving the exam that you chose to reschedule.
- Take the exam during the agreed upon rescheduled time or you will be marked as unexcused absent.
- Buses will run as usual. They will do a normal pick-up run in the morning and will leave at 1:45 PM for a drop-off run; late buses will run as usual. There will be no bus transportation between exams. On Monday, February 1 there will be no regular bus runs. Instead, there will be an East Side and West Side bus run in both the morning and the afternoon.
- A quiet study hall will be available to students in the FHS library.
