Graduation Rehearsal

As noted above, graduation rehearsals will be held at 12:45 p.m. on Tuesday, June 11, and at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 12. *These rehearsals are mandatory for all seniors*. Any senior not attending rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in the graduation ceremony. Caps, gowns, and tickets will be distributed at rehearsal. Students may come casually dressed for rehearsals.

Graduation

Graduation is scheduled to begin promptly at 6:00 p.m. Each graduate will receive five tickets for preferred seating on the field. (Please note: If rain cancels the outdoor ceremony, graduation will be held in the new gymnasium, with three green tickets providing seating for three guests in the bleachers. All other guests may watch the ceremony on closed-circuit television in the auditorium or a classroom.)

If a graduate does not intend to attend the graduation ceremony, please notify me by Friday, June 7.

Graduates should arrive by 5:00 p.m. Traffic will be heavy, so please plan accordingly to arrive on time. Due to parking limitations, it would be helpful if graduates are dropped off at the high school rather than driving themselves.

Limited handicap seating is available for those in a wheelchair, as well as signing services for the hearing impaired. Please contact Denise Martin at the high school at 673-2514 for these accommodations.

Turf Football Field

To protect the turf field where graduation is held, **only shoes without pointed heels are allowed for both graduates and guests**.
