

Irving Robbins Students Support Relay For Life

Relay for Life of Farmington Valley will be held this Saturday, May 18. The Relay For Life of Farmington Valley has expanded and has moved from the Farmington Polo Grounds to a larger site at 1690 New Britain Avenue in Farmington. The 1,800 members of fundraising teams who have been working all year to raise money to support the work of the American Cancer Society will be joined by 150 students and their parents from Irving Robbins Middle School. Irving Robbins students and their parents have already raised an amazing \$37,000. This year's Relay will include a celebration honoring survivors and caregivers at 4 p.m. Survivors are encouraged to register between 12 noon and 3:30 p.m. in the survivor tent. The Remember Ceremony, remembering those who have passed from the disease, will be held at 8:30 p.m. All members of the community are invited to join in the activities during the day as well as the special celebrations.
