

Classifications

Class I:

School related student, teacher, and parent groups.
 Examples: Student clubs, Parent – Teacher Organization meetings.

Class II: (proof of 501(c)3 or 501(c)4 status)

- A. Youth Organizations. Examples: Brownies, Scouts, 4-H, athletic associations, etc.
- B. Special meetings sponsored by local non-profit organizations which are general interest, educational, open to the public, and no admission is charged.

Class III:

- A. For-profit groups and/or private groups that provide educational, civic, recreational or charitable activities and do not charge an admission.
- B. Church sponsored recreation programs.

Class IV:

- A. Farmington church services/meetings, non-profit organization fundraising events and other requests not covered in Class I, Class II or Class III.
 Example: Parent – Teacher Organization fundraisers.
- B. Farmington commercial or business requests which are not intended to promote a product or service.
- C. Farmington organized community groups when charging an admission fee and/or when a majority of the group are not residents of the school district.

Class V:

- A. Non-Farmington church services/meetings, non-profit organization fundraising events, and other requests not covered in Class I, Class II or Class III.
- B. Non-Farmington commercial or business requests which are not intended to promote a product or service.
