The Farmington Public Schools participate in the Indoor Air Quality (IAQ) Tools for Schools Program. This is a program sponsored by the U.S. Department of Environmental Protection and the Connecticut State Department of Public Health. School-based Tools for Schools committees meet during the school year to implement the IAQ Tools for Schools process to maintain comfortable, healthy buildings for school occupants.

Members of each school-based committee may include a school administrator, the school nurse, faculty and/or staff member, school Head Custodian and district-wide Director of School Facilities. In addition to the school-based Tools for Schools committees, school facility personnel are kept apprised of any school facility needs throughout the year through an interactive, online work order management system that is available to any and all staff.
