



We are most appreciative of your thoughtful consideration of the Farmington Collaborative Preschool. Please take a moment to read this description of how child placement works within the program.

1. Our interest list opens annually on October 1st.
2. Families must officially demonstrate their interest in the program by visiting the Farmington Collaborative Preschool website and submitting the electronic form where it says, "***Click [here](#) to add your child's name to our 2019-2020 Interest List!***"
3. Parents are given the opportunity to specify two (of four) location preferences for placement: Irving A. Robbins, Noah Wallace, Union, and West District. Placement is offered based on these selections only.
4. Fairness is ensured in the placement process as all submissions are electronically time and date stamped by our system. Once the user clicks on the 'Submit' button upon completing the online form, entries are validated.
5. You will know that your submission has been accepted when you see a text box that reads, "The Farmington Collaborative Preschool. Thank you for filling out this form."
6. Once it has been determined in the spring as to how many preschool spots are available, we will then reach out to families based on the date and time that their submission was received. Placement is granted on a first-come-first-serve basis.
7. At that time, parents will be given further instruction regarding their child's online registration through the Farmington Public School website.
8. Online registrations that are received without going through the above listed channels will be discarded.

* Please note: Families who have submitted interest for the PreK3 program the previous year and do not receive placement are asked to resubmit their interest the following October. Submissions do not roll over from year-to-year.
