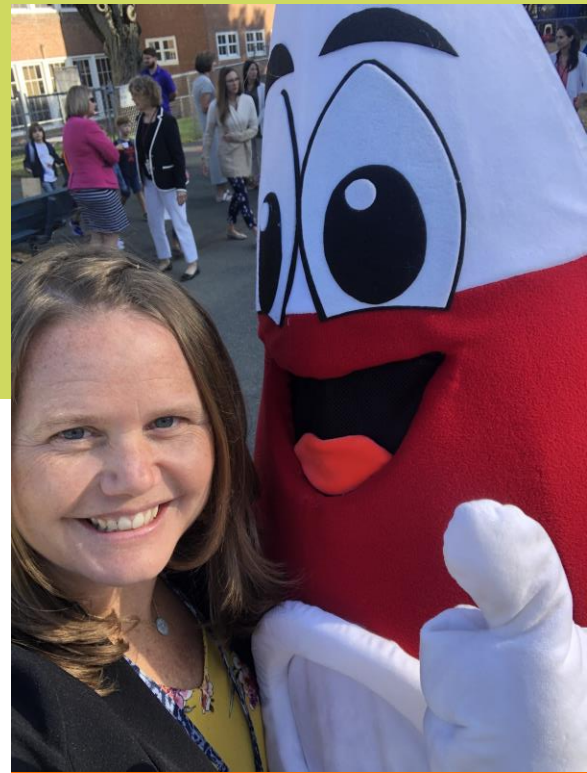

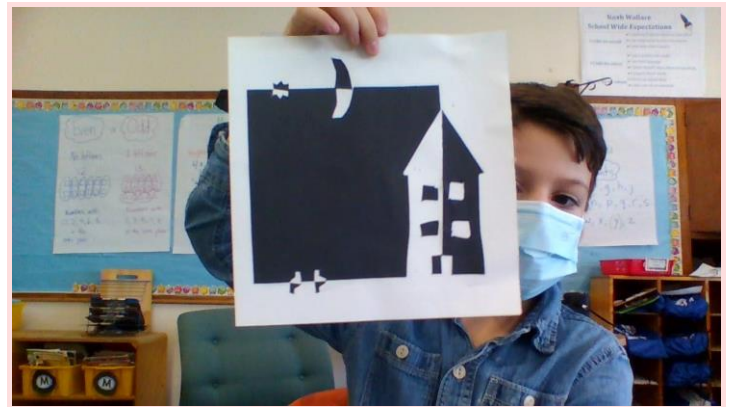
ART NEWS CONTINUED
