Please know that **all decision-making related to COVID-19 has been and will continue to be made in consultation or at the direction of the FVHD, DPH, CSDE, Governor Lamont and other partners. This same informed decision-making approach will be taken when it comes to potential school closures.** We consult with medical experts in all decision-making related to COVID-19 to ensure decisions focus upon the safety, health and well-being of our students, faculty, staff and community.

The FVHD has assured us that we are following all of the best practice recommendations to limit the spread of COVID-19. **Per the FVHD, school closures are not recommended in Farmington at this time.** Again, this is an **evolving health issue** and **decisions may quickly change.** We will keep all families, faculty and staff informed as new information is available and/or as new action steps are taken.

**Although no decisions have been made about closures at this time,** COVID-19 is an evolving health issue that can change rapidly. We are diligently tracking daily attendance, implementing all recommended proactive measures and we are in constant, daily contact with the FVHD and other partners. We have implemented a streamlined communication approach for our families beginning today.
